Possibly climb Glacier Peak. Call Martha Yale, 549-2163.

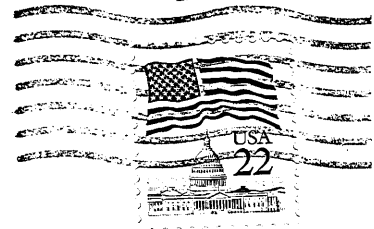
Saturday, August 2 - Holland Peak - Strenuous 9300 Ft., 5000 vertical. Call Art Gidel, 543-6352.

TRIP REPORTS

June 6, Riddell Lake - Ethel MacDonald, Bret Doucette, Ralph Flockerzi and Martha Yale hiked into the Riddell Lake area just south of Gray Wolf peak. After lunch at the upper lake, we hiked first to the east ridge above the lake, with good views of the lake and cirque. On the way out we hiked up and over the peak on the west, which afforded wonderful views of North Fish Basin, St. Mary's peak, Lowrey, and Mountaineer in the back.

Riddell lakes are reached by a poor trail which starts near the Twin Lake area east of St. Ignatius. To find it, turn left (north) on a road just east of the most eastern Twin Lake. At the first of three forks in the road go left. About 30 min. from where you park your car, a trail takes off to the right. This goes up a steep ridge and stays west of Grizzly creek.


